

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-20

Whereas, the City of Seminole desires to increase utilization of camping facilities at Sportsman Lake during fall and winter months; and

Whereas, the City of Seminole desires to maintain Sportsman Lake primarily as a recreational facility, and

Whereas, the City Council endeavors to enhance facilities at Sportsman Lake by dedicating fees collected in association with long-term camping toward providing improvements to Sportsman Lake facilities in addition to currently budgeted funds;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of Seminole that camping in excess of fifteen (15) days will be allowed from November 15, 2008 through March 1, 2009 at Sportsman Lake with the following limitations: (1) maximum of four adults per camper; (2) maximum of four long-term campers in full-service camping spaces at any one time; and (3) non-refundable fee of \$400 per month, payable in advance.

Adopted this 11th day of November 2008 at a regularly scheduled meeting of the governing body, in compliance with the Open Meeting Act, 25 O.S., Section 301, et seq.
